**WHAT IS ANGEL TREE?**

Angel Tree gives prisoners the opportunity to send a Christmas gift to their children.

**HOW DOES IT WORK?**

PF volunteers across England and Wales buy, wrap and send gifts on prisoners' behalf with a personal message written by the prisoner to make the gift extra special. Gifts are accompanied by a Christian storybook. It costs £15 to send a gift to each child.

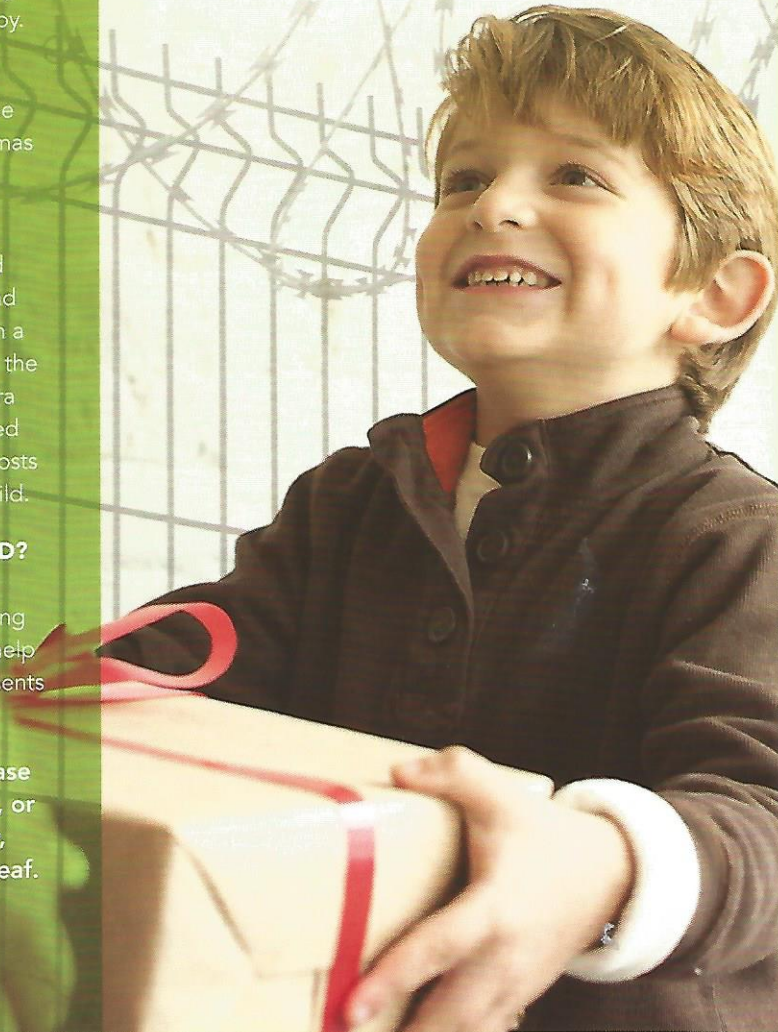
